Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP) (from Auditor General's Report 2019)

Low recovery of YLP funds: whereas groups were funded Shs. 325,213,000 in FY 2016/17 and FY 2017/18, only Shs. 92,987,500 (28.6%) had been repaid by end of FY 2018/2019

Women Enterprise Programme: out of Shs. 220,104,402 (includes the 5% surcharge) disbursed to the women groups in financial years 2016/2017 and 2017/2018, only Shs. 86,318,700 (39.2%) was recovered.

Education (UBOS Census Report of 2014)

- Number of persons aged 6-15 years not attending school is 11,456
- Persons aged 15 years and above whose highest level of education is below S.4 was 94,783 (91.1%)
- 40,201 persons aged 18 years and above who are illiterate

Construction of St. Matia Mulumba Seed School under the UgIFT Loan

Cost: Shs1, 848,303,400 of which Shs723, 782,000 was received during the year.

Inspection results:

- Incomplete works on all structures.
- Original plan was to construct Kikoora Seed school but changed to St. Matia Mulumba Seed School.

Health (UBOS Census Report of 2014)

- 37.5 % households were found to be 5 Km or more to the nearest health facility
- Only 1.4 % households had access to piped water
- 2,300 households were without any toilet facility

- 98.9% households were not living in decent dwellings.

Upgrade of Birembo and Masaka Health Centres II to HC III status under UgIFT loan

Cost: Shs. 1,698,330,636

Inspection results:

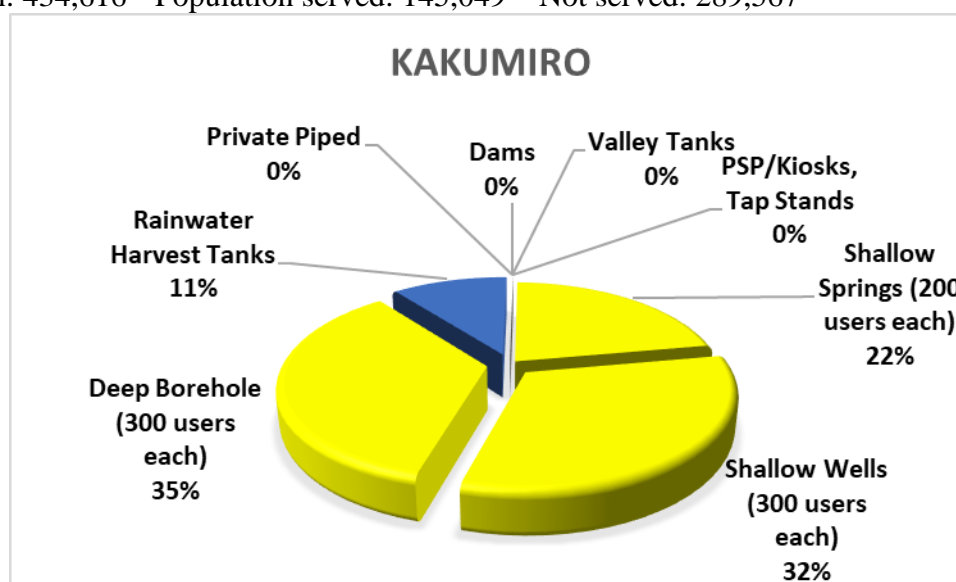
- Incomplete works on the maternity wards and medical waste pits.
- No provision for 4 stance VIP latrines and showers.
- No provision of placenta pits.
- The original plan was to upgrade Igayaza HC II but changed to Birembo HC
