- 2,752 households were without any toilet facility
- 90,345 (98.8%) households were not living in decent dwellings.
- > Upgrade of Myeri Health Centre II to Health Centre III status funded by the UgIFT loan
- ➤ Upgrade of Kyankaramata Health Centres II to Health Center III status funded by the UgIFT loan (from Auditor General's Report 2019)

- X-ray department not operational due lack of basic medical equipment.
- 10 other departments e.g. Maternity, Theatre and Laboratory were not equipped to the required standards.

Distribution of Source of Energy Per Household for Lighting (UBOS Census 2014)





Wetlands

Forests

- 90% of the population cooks with firewood. Without access to clean energy, deforestation will continue (UBOS)
- only two environmental police officers, who also work in Kyegegwa district (from Uganda Radio Network 27th February 2014).
