Underfunding: In the financial year 2017/18, the district budgeted to receive Shs. 277,160,860 for YLP but only Shs. 186,248,000 (67%) was received resulting in a shortfall of Shs. 90,912,860 (33%).

Low recovery of YLP funds: 63% of repayments are outstanding. Out of Shs. 385,205,995 advanced in financial years 2014/2015 and 2015/2016 had been recovered resulting in an outstanding balance of Shs. 243,220,200.


