### Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP) from Auditor General's Report 2019

**Low recovery of YLP funds:** Whereas the groups funded the 2015/2016 were expected to have repaid a total amount of Shs. 246,976,347 (Interest inclusive) by close of the financial year 2018/2019, only Shs 78,352,100 (32 %) was repaid.

The two sample youth groups visited had broken up and were no longer working.

- Works ongoing as a result of procurement delays.

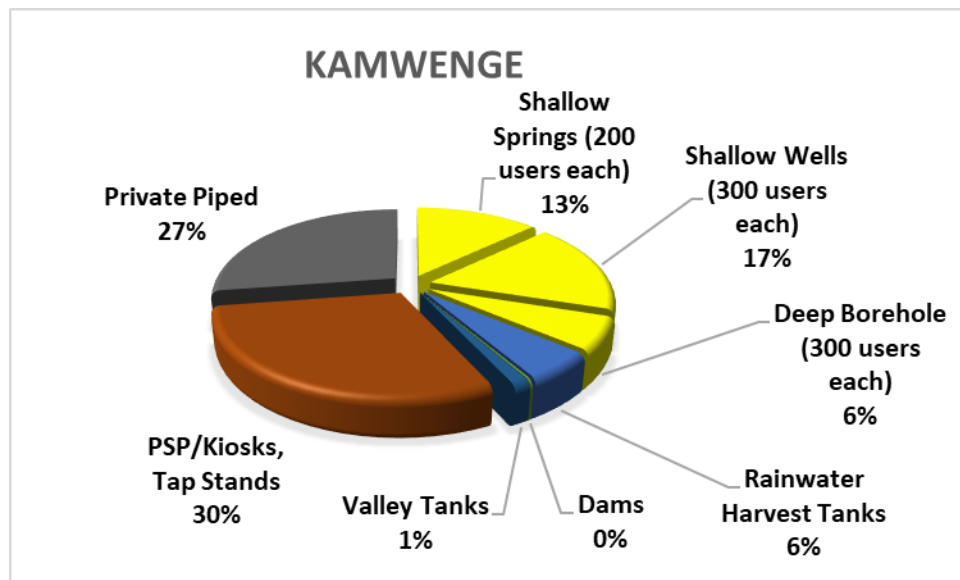

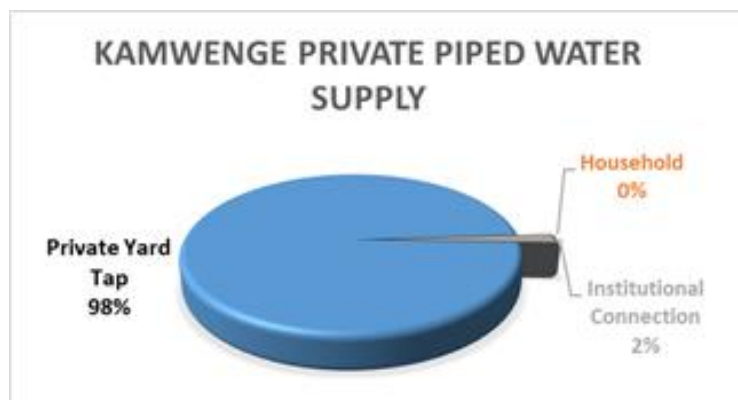
