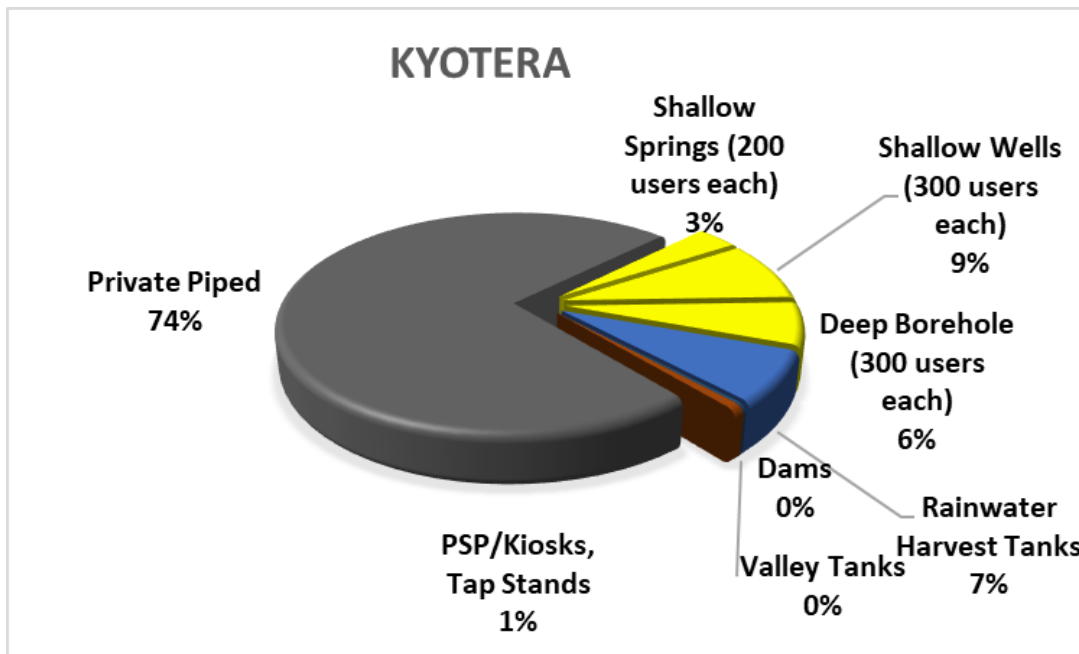

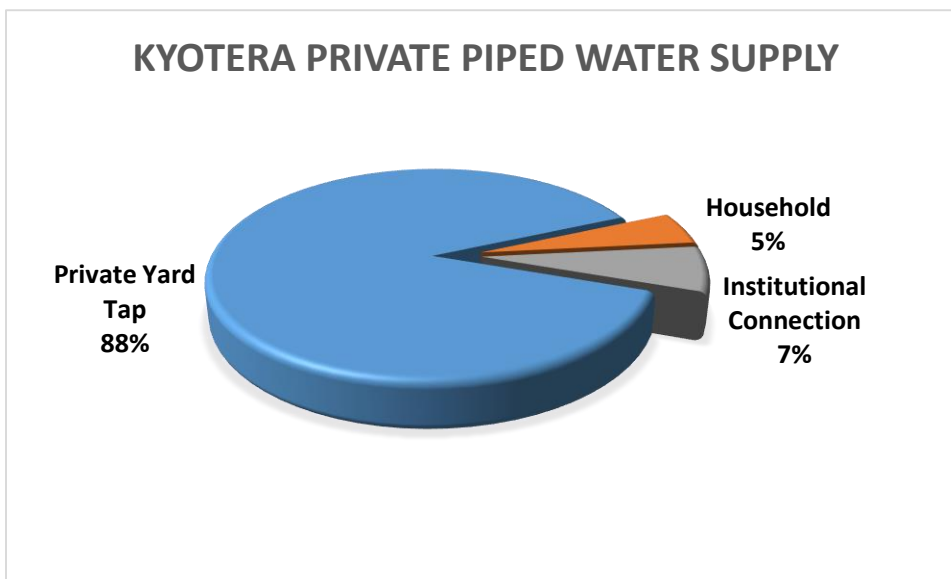

## Kyotera District Profile

### Environmental Protection

- Underfunding: the district budgeted Shs. 20,000,000 for natural resources management but revealed Shs. 6,800,000 (34%) to the natural resources office leading to a shortfall of Shs. 13,200,000.

- Unlicensed activities in the wetlands (risking depletion).
