# Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP) (from Auditor General's Report)

**Low recovery of YLP funds:** only Shs. 92,543,000 (22.5%) out of Shs. 410,757,124 disbursed in the financial years 2015/2016 and 2014/2015 had been recovered.

**Women Enterprise Programme:** out of Shs. 107,181,000 outstanding amount for the financial years 2016/17 and 2017/18, a sum of Shs. 52,000,300 had been recovered.

### Education

- Number of persons aged 6-15 years not attending school is 3,395
- Persons aged 15 years and above whose highest level of education is below S.4 was 49,904 (88.9 %)
- 18,930 persons aged 18 years and above who are illiterate

# Construction of Kyayi Seed School (AG 2019)

Cost: Shs. 309,000,000. Extra funds were mobilized by the district to meet the advance payment.

Despite an advance payment of Shs. 355,000,000 (17.6%) to the contractor, no physical construction activity had taken place at the proposed site

**UPE capitation grant**: insufficient according to inspection of a sample school.

### Health (UBOS Census Report of 2014)

- 27.4% households were found to be 5 Km or more to the nearest health facility
- Only 3.4 % households had access to piped water
- 2,653 households were without any toilet facility
- 97.6% households were not living in decent dwellings.

# Maddu Health Centre IV (AG 2018)

- Insufficient medical equipment: insufficient in number, need replacement and others were lacking. Patients are referred to distant facilities.
- Understaffing: The health centre has an approved staff structure of 48 staff. Out of the approved staff structure, only 32 (67%) positions were filled, leaving 16 (33%) positions vacant.


