

Failed Interventions: Governance

Uganda Public Service Performance Enhancement Program (UPS-PEP) 2009 - 2014

1. Funding: World Bank & IDA 51,100,000.00, foreign sources
2. Completion Report rating: Unsatisfactory, borrower and lender performance: unsatisfactory.

The Second Economic and Financial Management Project (EFMP II) 1999 - 2006

3. Cost: US\$73.18 million (against an estimate of US\$42.3 million)

Civil Service Reform Programme 1991 - 1996

Cost: \$17.1

4. Objectives: Affordability of government by reduction of number of ministries to twenty-one from 38; retrenchment of non-performers and surplus staff, recruitment freeze; demobilization of 50,000 soldiers.
5. Salary enhancement and re-skilling of retained staff. Salaries were tripled.

Outcomes

Economic loss. Total local government losses through financial mismanagement and lack of capacity in 2015/2016 alone: Shs. 33.6 billion or US\$9.62. In 2016 the Auditor General attributed the loss to lack of qualified staff.
