### Education (UBOS Census Report of 2014)

- Number of persons aged 6-15 years not attending school: 5,231
- Persons aged 15 years and above whose highest level of education is below S.4: 89,288 (74.0 %)
- 19,297 persons aged 18 years and above who are illiterate

### Health (UBOS Census Report of 2014)

- 9.7% households were found to be 5 km or more to the nearest health facility
- Only 41.4 % households had access to piped water
- 1,100 households were without any toilet facility
- 3,528 (4.7%) households were not living in decent dwellings.

### **Bukulula Health Centre IV (from Auditor General, 2018)**

- **Maternity section:** leaking.
- **Outpatient Department:** dilapidated with broken windows, unpainted cracked walls and leaking roof among others

## Unemployment

### Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP)

**Budget shortfall:** out of the approved budget Shs. 305,285,000 only Shs. 255,941,471 was transferred by Central Government to Kalungu LG resulting in a short fall of Shs. 49,343,529.

**Low recovery of YLP funds:** out of Shs. 322,910,800 disbursed to the groups in 2014/2015a and 2015/2016 Shs.117.273,500 had been repaid leaving an outstanding balance of Shs. 219,989,500 which would have been used to fund new groups.

### Women Enterprise Programme

**Low-recovery of disbursed UWEP funds:** out of Shs. 215,400,000 disbursed only Shs. 67,428,000 had been repaid resulting in an outstanding amount of Shs. 151,708,370 (5% interest inclusive).

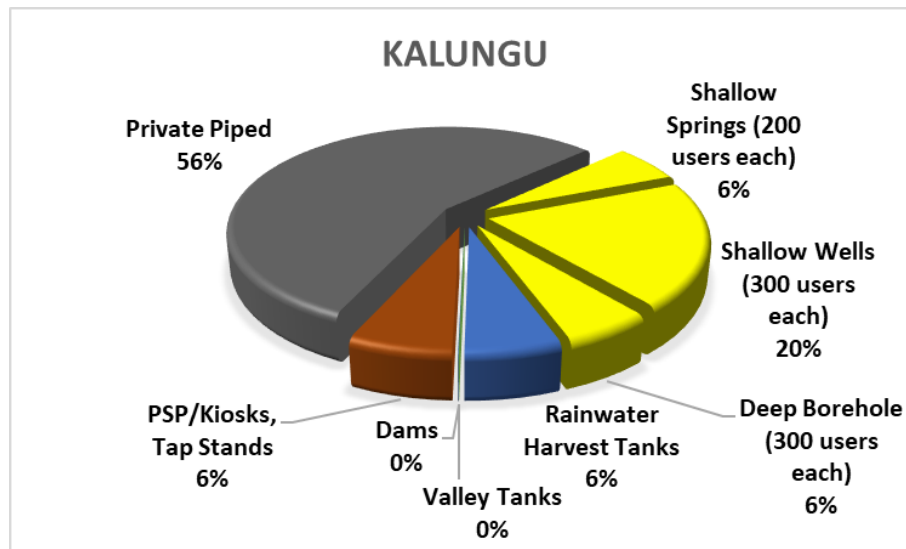

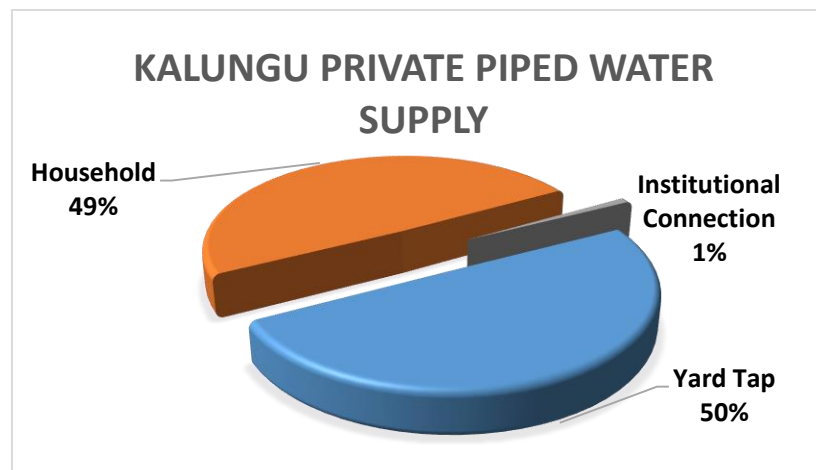

### Access to Water

**Underfunding (from the Auditor General's Report 2019):** The District budgeted Shs.282, 975,000 for 2018/2019 but received Shs. 281,973,181 resulting in underfunding of Shs. 1,001,819.

**Non-functional water points:** Kalungu has a total of 764 different water sources and out of which, a total of 159 (20.81%) are non-functional. The number of safe water for domestic use is insufficient compared to the strategic plan. People move long distances for water.

### **Un-demarcated boundaries of wetlands and forest reserves**

- Extensive encroachment on 22 wetland systems including Luweero. They are being used for farming, eucalyptus and vegetable growing.
- The District has only recently re-activated its District Environmental Committee to manage the natural resources.
