Location

Central part of Uganda with its headquarters 179.7 Km from Kampala by road.

Neighbours: East – Masaka; North; Sembabule; South - Rakai North East – Bukomansimbi; West- Lyantonde

Major Economic Activity: livestock keeping, Fishing, Trade and pit sawing.

Unemployment: 3,198 youths aged 18-30 years who were neither working nor in school by 2014

Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP) (from the Auditor General's Report 2019)

Underfunding: out of SHS. 239,769,000 budgeted, SHS. 217,431,000 was received resulting in a short fall of SHS. 22,338,000.

Low recovery of YLP funds: only SHS. 136,243,500 out of SHS. 400,463,950 disbursed was recovered in the period 2014/2015 to 2016/2017.

Education

- Number of persons aged 6-15 years not attending school is 6,600
- Persons aged 15 years and above whose highest level of education is below S.4 was 84,116 (86.7%)
- 27,201 persons aged 18 years and above who are illiterate

Health (UBOS Census Report of 2014)

- 17.9% households were found to be 5 Km or more to the nearest health facility
- Only 4.3 % households had access to piped water
- 1,791 2 households were without any toilet facility
- 96.3% households were not living in decent dwellings.

Condition of medical equipment: much is obsolete, faulty and not in fair condition ~ AG 2018.

- Understaffing: only 22 out of 47 positions filled.
- Patient accommodation: the maternity ward and the female wards were too small to accommodate daily admissions.
- Had Ophthalmic staff but no equipment

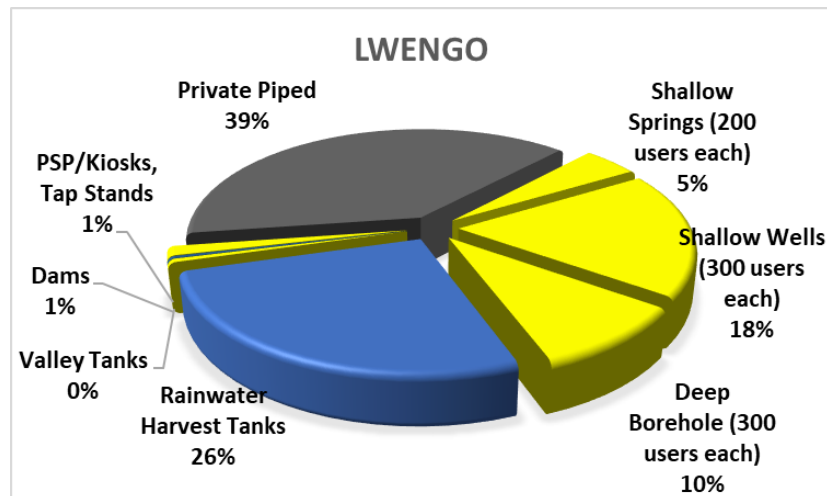
- Had Ophthalmic staff but no equipment

Access to Energy for Lighting (UBOS Census 2014)

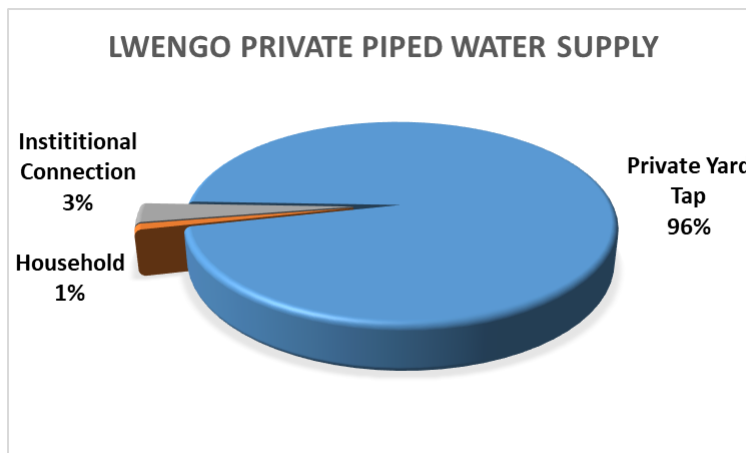
