Western part of Uganda with its headquarters 347.8 km from Kampala by road.

Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP)

Low recovery of YLP funds: groups expected to have repaid a total amount of Shs. 363,484,200 (interest Inclusive only Shs. 164,934,800 had been repaid, leaving a balance of Shs. 198,549,400 outstanding.

Education

- Number of persons aged 6-15 years not attending school is 4,376
- Persons aged 15 years and above whose highest level of education is below S.4 was 52,658 (85.1%)
- 21,164 persons aged 18 years and above who are illiterate

Construction of Mayanga Seed School

- Under-funded

Health (UBOS Census Report of 2014)

- 27.3% households were found to be 5 km or more to the nearest health facility
- Only 5.5% households had access to piped water
- 379 households were without any toilet facility
- 98.7% households were not living in decent dwellings.

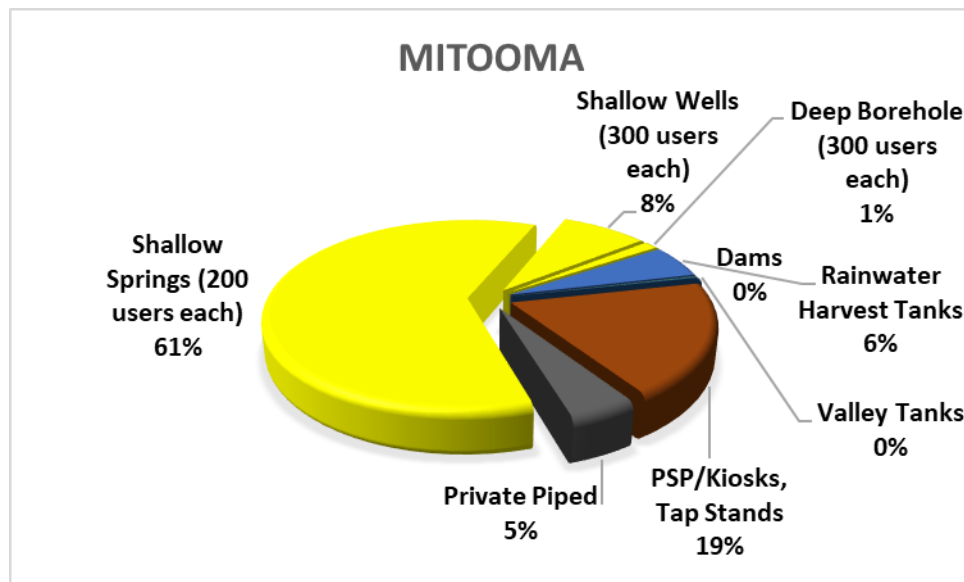

Environmental Protection (per Auditor General 2018)

- Key environment sector staff not recruited; Senior Environmental Officer, Environmental Officer, Forestry Officer, Land Valuer, Registrar of Titles, Cartographer, Assistant Records Officer, District Planner “lack of competent technical capacity/technocrats to guide in the management and utilization of natural resources.”
- Unlicensed activities over 30 wetlands; over grazing, cultivations, tree planting and dairy farming.
